Dr. Klaus Jacob is political scientist and research director of the Environmental Policy Research Centre (FFU) at the Freie Universitaet Berlin. He is head of the research group on Policy Assessment which works on Impact Assessments, evidence-based policy making, strategies in environmental and sustainability policy, ecological modernization as well as innovation and lead markets for environmental innovation. Klaus Jacob applies methods of policy analysis for his work in different issue areas. He is co-coordinator of the European network of excellence LIAISE, which develops models in support of impact assessment. He is chair of the steering committee of the Berlin Conferences series on Global Environmental Change, and has been Lead Author for the Global Environmental Outlook 4, reviewer for GEO 5 and Coordinating Lead Author of GEO 6 of the United Nations Environmental Program, as well as the president of the executive board of "The Integrated Assessment Society" (TIAS). Klaus Jacob teaches courses in policy analysis as well as political science methods and theories at the Otto-Suhr-Institute of Freie Universität Berlin. His research projects range from applied consultancy for national and international clients to basic research.
