In addition to the above examples of special needs, staff in each of these profiles shall have basic knowledge of the Windows NT and Microsoft Office environment used at the Agency.

For these and related needs the tenderer shall propose a list of courses that he can offer. From this list and its regular updates, the EEA can then subscribe courses as needed. These courses will form a part of EEA's internally managed training programme.

The training shall in principle be in the English language. Courses can be offered in other languages if all the trainees agree.

The courses can be offered alternatively in the tenderer's location and at EEA. The location shall be determined on a case by case basis. For courses held at EEA, the classroom and facilities will be provided.
