The local component shall provide more detailed information, complementary to the pan-European component, over specific areas of interest (riparian zones) using very high-resolution (VHR) imagery collected between 2011/2013 in combination with other available datasets (high-resolution and medium-resolution images) over the

pan-European area. To allow for systematic assessment of freshwater ecosystems and riverine habitats, spatial information on extent, distribution and land cover/land use and their characteristics of riparian zones is required. A tailored LC/LU classification is needed with a finer minimum mapping unit, a more detailed nomenclature, inclusion of green linear elements, etc. as compared to Corine land cover.
