Bergþóra Njála Guðmundsdóttir is a deputy director at the Icelandic Ministry of the Environment, Energy and Climate, Department of International Affairs. She represents Iceland in the Committee of Senior Officials for the Environment and Climate under the Nordic Council of Ministers and is a member of the EEA Management Board. She is also a member of the governmental team working for Sustainable Iceland, which is responsible for implementing the governmental policy on sustainable development as well as the UN Sustainable Development Goals.



She holds a M.Sc. degree in Environment and Natural Resource studies, a diploma in Journalism and a cand.mag degree in Music. She has been working at the Icelandic Ministry for the Environment and Natural Resources since May 2011, where she served as the Head of Information until 2020. In that role she also served periodically at the National Crisis Coordination Centre, mostly during natural hazards and as an information specialist during the Covid-19 pandemic.

Before her time at the Ministry Bergþóra had a career as a journalist for newspaper and television in the years 2000-2011.
