6. Data Sharing and Disclosure

Your data will be handled confidentially and will only be shared with:

- Third-party service providers who support our research activities, in compliance with strict data protection agreements (Trinidad Wiseman.)

We will never sell or share your personal data with third parties for marketing or advertising purposes.

7. Data Retention Period

We will retain your data only as long as necessary for the purposes outlined in this notice. Once your data is no longer needed, it will be securely deleted or anonymized.

8. Your Rights
